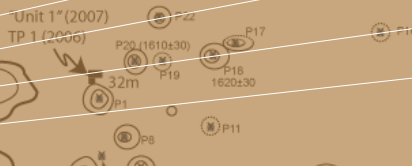

Access

By City Subway and Kyoto Bus

From Kyoto Station, take the Karasuma Line to Kokusai Kaikan Station (the last station), and transfer to Kyoto Bus. From Kokusai Kaikan Station, take bus No. 40, 50 or 52 to Chikyuken-mae. RIHN is at the base of the hill on your left.

By Eizan Railway

From Demachiyangagi Station in Kyoto City, take the Kurama Line. Get off at Kyoto-Seikadai-mae Station. RIHN is a 10-minute walk from the station.

By Car, Taxi
