<p><b>General advice and comments of the PEC:</b></p> <p>This project has made major achievements in a relatively short timeframe and the PEC regards it as being highly compatible with the founding mission and research approach of RIHN.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. While some commented that the work at Laguna Bay does not justify the title “Asian Watersheds,” but it may have been in part because of the sharp focus that the project achieved its success. The PEC feels it is worth for RIHN to find ways to build on the project and find ways to continue the research with the project partners.</li><li>2. Should the work continue, a stronger anthropological engagement in the field is recommended. Also, even stronger efforts to transmit results to communities and government would be expected.</li></ol>
