<b>General advice and comments of the PEC:</b>			
<p>The PEC wholeheartedly confirmed the important role that stable isotope techniques have in the research at RIHN as well as its potential in future research. The proposal is therefore valuable, but it would benefit from more preparation before launching into the Full Research stage.</p>			
<p>One area for clarification is whether the main focus of the project would be to develop new isotope techniques or methodologies for using such techniques on society in transdisciplinary research. In the current proposal, the scope and methodology for the transdisciplinary dimension were not very clearly defined.</p>
