General advice and comments of the EREC:

The Committee noted that the Aakash Project had been impacted in major ways by the COVID-19 pandemic just as it was about to start its activities at full throttle. The pandemic made international travel impossible and constrained local fieldwork. The project team, however, responded well and adapted to the situation by working with Indian partner organizations for some of the fieldwork. Furthermore, it took advantage of the unexpected "experimental" situation of reduced pollutant emissions in India due to pandemic countermeasures by actively studying this phenomenon. Thus, in spite of the setbacks due to the pandemic, the project has been very active and is making good progress.
