- June 20-22 (Official governmental summit on declaration of the summit agenda)
- ・ 政治機関、企業、NGOs、学者コミュニティー、その他のステークホルダーの参加
- Targets:

 - 社会的公正の推進、
 - 環境保護を確保
- To mark
 - the 20th anniversary of Rio Summit of 1992 (UN Conference of Environment and Development)
 - The 10th anniversary of Johannesburg Summit of 2002 (World Summit on Sustainable Development)

Post-Rio+20

- Rio Document was released with presence of 191 states (according to Ban Ki Moon, UN Secretary-General) and 50,000 participants of all late May and June events.
 - (--)Some blame the document to be very weak and, given the environment of EU crisis and US domestic struggles, out of attention.
 - (+) Some praise the document as being constructive and still having an intention to initiate change towards green economy/society
- What we sensed in Rio:
- more intense discussions with online consultation and presence
- rather negative and conscious mood with more scientific evidence of global environmental change and recognition of the fact that humanity has reached it's environmental and societal limits at certain thresholds
- though governmental negotiations were as expected, real initiatives took place at side events (remarkable quantity and quality of meetings at Athletes Park and other conferences) as incubators of real discussions and initiatives

Post-Rio+20

- After Rio:
- Bolstering initiatives an institution frameworks were already initiated at 1992 Earth Summit.
- So, Rio+20 was more of a venue to raise awareness and recognition on the dire need to take action against problems of social inequity and environmental degradation.
 - ★ Ideal (on the paper): Green economy and sustainable development.
 - ★ Reality of our time: With all the financial and structural crisis in the West and uncontrollable development in Asia, Latin America and poverty in Africa, governments are prone to save themselves before saving the planet.
 - ★ At the end of the day: Trans-disciplinary, trans-sectoral interaction.
 - ★ Key sentence: How to sustain development with aware, fair and timely social, economic and environmental policies and actions.


