<p>General advice and comments of the PEC:</p> <p>This has been a solid and well-focused project with considerable achievements and the PEC regards it as compatible with the founding mission and research approach of RIHN.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It is somewhat harder to discern where the research has been really novel or unique.2. The project seems to have been strongest in the natural science area, where the team leader is most comfortable. The ethnographic fieldwork seems to have been a relatively weaker part of the project.3. Even though the project has been completed, the PEC recommends that efforts be continued to place the work in the international literature through English-language and peer reviewed publications and linking with researchers addressing similar issues.
